

Sherborn Advisory Committee Minutes
October 24, 2016

Attendance

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at Lindquist Commons in Dover at 6:32 PM by Mr. Morrill.

Solar Panel Warrant Article

Jeff Waldron updated the committee on new developments concerning the terms of a prospective solar panel installation agreement.

After the discussion, Jeff Waldron moved to recommend favorable action on Article 1. Mary Wolff seconded. The motion carried 8 – 1. Article 1 is recited below.

Article 1 (Proponents - Board of Selectman) – To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen (i) to enter into an agreement for the purchase of electricity and/or net metering credits generated by a solar photovoltaic facility to be installed on the roof of the CM&D garage at 7 Butler St., with such agreement to be for a term of up to twenty (20) years, and on such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deems in the best interests of the Town; and, (ii) to take all actions necessary or appropriate to administer and implement such agreement; or take any other action relative thereto.

Jeff Waldron also moved to recommend favorable action on Article 2. Susan Aharonian seconded. The motion carried 8 – 1. Article 2 is recited below.

Article 2 (Proponents - Board of Selectman) – To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen (i) to enter into an agreement for “payments in lieu of taxes” pursuant to M.G.L. c. 59, s. 38H(b), or any other enabling authority, for personal property and/or real property taxes attributable to a solar photovoltaic facility to be installed on the roof of the CM&D garage at 7 Butler St., with such agreement to be for a term of up to twenty (20) years and on such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deems in the best interests of the Town; and, (ii) to take all actions necessary or appropriate to administer and implement such agreement; or take any other action relative thereto.

Adjournment

The meeting was continued into Town Meeting at 6:55 PM and adjourned at the end of Town Meeting.
