Speakers include local experts, and the teaching staff of Wellesley College, New England Aquarium, and Broadmoor Audubon Society. - Respite Care—Financial assistance to provide “in home care” will be provided to Sherborn families who are serving as primary caregivers for senior family members. This will provide the gift of time to a husband, a wife, son or daughter who need some well-deserved “me” time.
- Transportation—the Friends will provide transportation vouchers for Sherborn seniors who may need some financial assistance in paying for transportation services either locally or for medical transportation to Boston.
