- Purchase a dump truck for the Community Maintenance and Development department;

- Purchase a pick-up truck for the Community Maintenance and Development department;
- Install an asphalt overlay, and purchase and install fencing and containers at the transfer station;
- Purchase public safety communications equipment;
- Construct an emergency access road at the Pine Hill School;
- Pay for various items of capital equipment and improvements at the Pine Hill School, including the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto; and,
- Pay for the planning and engineering of improvements to the intersections of Woodland Street and Mill Street, and Woodland Street and Goulding Street West?
