## Vote YES on Capital Budget Override

Thanks to all who attended Sherborn's Town Meeting on Saturday and supported the Improvements at the Transfer Station. People may not realize that the struggle to get this accomplished is not finished; we still need to vote to approve the Capital Budget Override at the Town Election on May 14. The time to consider the capital budget issues individually was at Town Meeting, which is now over, so I am urging everyone to vote "yes" on Election Day May 14 on this question. If it does not pass, then the Improvements at the Transfer Station will have to wait until another year once again.

The improvements, especially the driveway, are most urgently needed for the safety of the people who use or work at the Transfer Station, but they will also go a long way towards improving its appearance. It is common for users to lose their footing on the [uneven surfaces](#) of the driveway, and delivery men who have pallets of bins have struggled to pull them through the [potholes](#). The floors of the containers are [rusted out](#) and we have placed planks of wood over the holes so we don't fall in, but we have to step carefully so we don't trip. The fence is supposed to keep people out when the gate is locked, but there are so many breaches that anyone can figure out [how to get in](#).

The Ballot Question will only ask whether or not the voters are in favor of ALL of the Capital Budget requests approved at Town Meeting. Voters will not be able to vote

on each separate issue the way they did at Town Meeting.

Go to the Town Election on Tuesday May 14 and vote in favor of the Capital Budget ballot override!
