Continuation of the hearing on the petition of Alan Williams for a Special Permit under Section 3.2.2a)1(b) for an additional housekeeping unit at 153 Nason Hill Road which is in a Residence C district.

Open the hearing process on the application of Gray Road, LLC (Benjamin T. Stevens, Manager), for a Comprehensive Permit pursuant to the provisions of Mass. Gen. Laws, Chapter 40B. The proposed development will consist of eighty eight (88) townhouse condominium units, twenty two (22) of which will be restricted to affordable housing. The parcel consists of approximately 20.02 acres and is located at 104 Coolidge Street, Map 5, Lots, 32 & 48A.
