Currently actively involved in the process of subdivision and permitting the land to construct 60 unit apartment building, 27 town houses, 10,000 s.f. market and retail.

90 Ocean at 90 Ocean Avenue, Revere, MA (Co-owner) – 75 unit multi-family apartment building. Actively involved in overseeing construction. Project due to be completed by August 2021.

Recent Projects:

As of November 2018, all units are sold. ROI is 64%. Actively involved in pre-purchase evaluation of the project, securing financing, selection of general contractor and overseeing construction.
